

Clematis CM219

Homeopathic Medicine

Available as: 1 fl. oz. (30ml) buccal or sublingual oral liquid

Indications and Usage:

For the temporary relief of pain, neuralgia and inflammation particularly for arthritis, rheumatism and acute episodes of chronic conditions. Promotes systemic detoxification.

Contraindications:

Clematis is contraindicated in patients who have a known sensitivity to the homeopathic ingredient at levels of 1 part per 10,000 or less.

Warnings:

Patients who experience a worsening of general symptoms, or who experience new symptoms, should seek medical attention.

If symptoms persist for more than 7 days, consult your physician. As with any drug, if you are pregnant or nursing a baby, seek the advice of a physician before using this product. Keep container tightly closed. **Keep this and all medicines out of the reach of children.**

Precautions:

General: Clematis has exhibited no known adverse systemic effects.

Drug Interactions: There is no evidence that Homeopathic drugs interact with conventional drugs. Inflammation is not known to have interactions with other drugs.

Pregnancy and Nursing: There is no information regarding homeopathic drug transmission across the placental barrier or excretion in human milk. The mother's condition should be the deciding factor in treatment selection.

Carcinogenesis, Mutagenesis, Impairment of Fertility, Impotence: Current and historical evidence indicated that homeopathic drugs are free of such side effects.

Adverse Reactions: No adverse experiences have been reported, however, it is possible for patients with hypersensitivity to one of the ingredients to exhibit general allergic symptoms or, in the most severe case, an anaphylactic reaction.

Drug Abuse and Dependence: There is no drug abuse or dependence associated with the use of homeopathic drugs.

Overdosage: Homeopathic drugs are generally considered to be nontoxic and LD50's are not measured. Should an accidental overdose occur symptoms such as headache, nausea or diarrhea may arise. Symptoms should be self limiting and resolve in 24 to 48 hours.

Dose and Administration:

Liquid: Clematis oral liquid homeopathic drug is administered for sublingual or buccal absorption. It is best taken in a mouth free of food or drink. Adults, take 10 drops 3 times daily. For acute symptoms, take 10 drops every 15 minutes, decreasing to hourly upon improvement. Children 2-12 years of age, take one half the adult dosage. For children under 2 years, consult your health care professional. **Alternate Dosage:** Take as directed by your health care professional.

Clinical Pharmacology:

Clematis Combination has been formulated to activate the body's healing processes in cases of chronic diseases. Conditions such as arthritis, rheumatism, neuralgia, asthma, hepatic disorders, colitis, various neurological conditions, urological, dermatological, ear, nose and throat may be treated with Clematis Combination.

Acidum Nitricum (Nitric Acid)	6X	Arthritis, dyscrasia, eczema, dermatosis, chronic nephritis.
Apis Mellifica (Honey Bee)	12X	Oedema, exerts a channeling action on the connective tissues, rheumatic pains.
Argentum Metallicum (Metallic Silver)	8X	Acts on bones, cartilage and ligaments, rheumatic affections, swelling of ankles.
Aurum Metallicum (Metallic Gold)	10X	Chronic conditions of the aged, edema, arthritis.
Betula alba (Birch)	2X	Diuretic, eczema, chills, coryza.
Calcarea Fluorica (Fluorspar)	6X	Lower back pain, glandular swelling.
Caltha palustris (Marsh Marigold)	3X	Bronchitis, pemphigus, uterine inflammation.
Clematis erecta (Virgin's Bower)	4X	Neuralgic and rheumatic pains, hard glandular swelling, urethral stricture, prostatitis, eczema.
Echinacea angustifolia (Cone Flower)	5X	Aching in limbs, strengthens the immune system, inflammations, septic processes.
Galium aparine (Cleavers)	3X	Pre-cancerous dermatitis, diuretic, edema, favors granulation of ulcers.
Hedera helix (English Ivy)	4X	Acute and chronic nasal catarrh, nasal and sinus catarrh.
Juniperus communis (Common Juniper)	4X	Diuretic, glomerulonephritis.
Ononis spinosa (Common Rest-harrow)	4X	Nephrosis, nasal hemorrhage.
Phosphorus (Yellow Phosphorus)	8X	Affections of the parenchyma, lungs, heart, liver and kidneys, decalcification of the bone.
Pyrogenium nosode (Pyrogen)	14X	Infectious conditions, oedema.
Quaillaia saponaria (Soap Bark)	4X	Diuretic, mucosal catarrh, gastritis.

Sedum acre (Mossy Stonecrop)	3X	Constricting pain, hemorrhoidal disorders.
Sempervivum tectorum (Houseleek)	4X	Pre-cancerous dermatitis, herpes zoster, hemorrhoids, nephtritis.
Thuja occidentalis (White Cedar)	3Х	Muscle twitching, weakness, trembling, cracking joints, constitutional remedy, especially for joints, diseases with a tendency towards proliferative processes.
Urtica urens (Dwarf Nettle)	3X	Rheumatism, gout, eczema and dermatosis.
