Blue Snowball Mic Quick Reference Guide

Record settings on back of Blue Snowball

Position 1 – For single user voice/instrument recording

Position 2 – For extra loud voices/instruments that may cause distortion

Position 3 – For group of voices or instruments

Windows XP computer Setup:

- 1. Connect mic to computer with USB cable
- 2. Wait for mic drivers to install
- 3. Click Start and choose Control Panel
- 4. Double-click the Sounds and Devices icon
- 5. Click the Audio tab
- 6. Change the Sound Recording Default Device to Blue Snowball
- 7. Click Volume and raise the volume level
- 8. Close the window
- 9. Click the Voice tab
- 10. Change the Voice Recording Default Device to Blue Snowball
- 11. Click Volume and raise the volume level
- 12. Click Apply or OK
- 13. In Audacity, click Edit from the menu and choose Preferences
- 14. Change the recording device to Blue Snowball
- 15. Click OK

Apple OSX Computer Setup:

- 1. Click System Preferences
- 2. Click the Sound icon
- 3. Click the Input tab
- 4. Under Choose a Device, click Blue Snowball
- 5. Increase the input volume
- 6. Close the window
- 7. In Garageband click the Info button
- 8. Select channel 1 mono in the Input field
- 9. Click Garageband from the menu and choose Preferences
- 10. Click the Input tab
- 11. Choose Blue Snowball as the Input device.
- 12. Click OK or Save
