

- Secure data—SSL/TLS (HTTPS) for secure communications, password-protected Embedded Web Server, DHCP option 81/RFC4702 /RFC4704, stateless protocol, FQDN, device syslog and firewall configurations for user access control and policies.
- Wireless authentication—The HP Embedded Web Server provides the ability to configure wireless networking via such 802.1x wireless enterprise authentication protocols as EAP-TLS, LEAP, and PEAP to support access control. The HP Embedded Web Server also provides the ability to configure wireless dynamic key encryption such as WEP, WPA-PSK, and WPA-2 Enterprise authentication.
- **Enable/disable features**—You can easily enable and disable features such as Wireless Direct Authentication, IPv6, HP ePrint, and HP wireless direct printing.<sup>14</sup>

#### Unattended, uninterrupted copying and scanning

You can copy, scan, or fax up to 50 legal-sized originals from the automatic document feeder (ADF). And with two-sided scanning and copying, you won't have to flip pages.

Automatic document

This smart MFP can multitask. You can receive a fax while the device is busy printing, and if someone walks up to make copies, it will prioritize that job over any print requests that come down the pipe.

#### Scan documents direct to network folders or email

HP Direct Digital Filing provides robust, general-office scanning, as well as versatile document management capabilities, for multiple users over a network.

With HP Direct Digital Filing, you can simply walk up to your HP Officejet Pro 276dw MFP, press the Scan icon on the control panel, and scan documents directly to folders on your network or quickly share them with business partners as email attachments—all without using additional scanning software. This MFP is TWAIN-compliant and Windows Imaging Application (WIA)-compliant. It works with Windowsbased programs that support TWAIN-compliant or WIA-compliant scanning devices, and with Macintoshbased programs that support TWAIN-compliant scanning devices.



#### Scan using optical character recognition (OCR)

To import scanned text into your preferred word-processing program for editing, open the HP Scan software and select the shortcut named Save as Editable Text (OCR).

#### Easily make copies—even of two-sided ID cards

Use the scan and copy features to make fast, easy copies. Capture both sides of a double-sided identification card and print them on one side of a single page for reporting and filing.

#### **Enhance copies using HP Copy Fix**

When you need to make copies in a hurry, sometimes an item might get slightly skewed on the scanner glass. This MFP can help you make it right with HP Copy Fix. This technology automatically detects and corrects page skew problems. HP Copy Fix can also automatically crop the copied image to prevent wasting ink on unwanted dark backgrounds.

With the device turned on, simply connect an Ethernet cable from the RJ-45 port to the network hub, switch, or router, and then run the installation software on each computer on the network. On-screen instructions provide easy step-by-step installation.

### **Connect hassle-free with wireless networking**

The HP Officejet Pro 200 series includes built-in wireless networking, so you can connect your printer or MFP directly to a Wi-Fi network without using an external print server. Wireless networking allows work teams with a wireless router and a notebook or desktop computer with a wireless card or adapter to print via a wireless connection—there's no need for a cable between the computer and the device. #### Save paper and reduce waste

Reduce paper use by up to 50% by printing two pages on a single sheet, using automatic two-sided printing. In managed print environments, HP Web Jetadmin can help cut the cost of paper consumption by setting automatic two-sided printing as the default for individual devices or entire fleets.<sup>10</sup> This feature is enabled in unmanaged environments, through the control panel or in the printer driver.

Reduce your impact on the environment. Printing the same number of pages, the HP Officejet Pro 200 series will use up to 50% fewer supplies and packaging, by weight, than a similar color laser printer.<sup>16</sup> Original HP pigment inks require less packaging than toner cartridges. And because these devices have no long-life consumables to replace (drums, fusers, etc.) there is significantly less waste material over the life of the product.
