Be sure to read this User Guide before you use the Headset. The TDROTH-03 has been developed using Bluetooth® wireless technology and is capable of connecting with Bluetooth® devices designed with Audio Gateway and PDAs. Desktop and notebook computers can be connected and paired with the Headset using a USB Bluetooth® Dongle. Before using the Headset, please verify your Bluetooth® device (phone, PDA) complies with Bluetooth® V2.1 and supports the Bluetooth® Headset or Handsfree A2DP AVRCP Profiles.

TDROTH-03 Bluetooth® Stereo Headset Structure

Primary Operation

1. Turn on: In the off state, Press the function button for 2 seconds. The indicator light will flash blue 3 times slowly.
2. Turn off: In the on state, Press the function button for 3 seconds. The indicator light will flash red 3 times slowly.
3. Put Headset in Pairing Mode: In the off state, press and hold the multifunction key 7 seconds until red and blue LED flash alternately.
4. Answer a call: Press the multifunction key one time while the call coming in to answer from the headset.
5. End a call: Press the multifunction key one time while the talking to end a call from the headset.
6. Reject a call: Press and hold multifunction key about 2 seconds to reject the incoming call.
7. Voice dialing: While in the headset and mobile connecting state, press and hold multifunction key 3 seconds until you hear a beep to operate the voice dialing. (to use this function, your mobile must support this option)
8. Redial number: Press the decrease volume button for 2 seconds.
9. Audio transfer between phone and headset: Press the increase volume button for 2 seconds
10. Mute/Cancel mute: Press the increase volume and decrease button at the same time

Pairing Headset with one Device:

- a. Turn on both the headset and the device.
- b. Hold the headset's multi-function button for 7 seconds till its blue and red indicator lights flash alternately, now the headset is ready to pair for any device.
- c. Activate Bluetooth® function of the device so the device is in

bluetooth searching mode and search for Bluetooth® devices (please refer to the device's manual for more instruction)
d. Select "TDROTH-03" among the device's searched devices list and then confirm according to its indications.
e. Input pin code "0000" if a passcode is asked for. Now confirm that the headset is paired, in which the blue indicator light flashes.

Pairing Headset with Two Devices

Bluetooth headset TDROTH-03 has multi-point function for connection to two mobile devices simultaneously.

- a. Please pair the first phone following above pairing steps.
- b. Turn off the first connected phone's Bluetooth function temporarily.
- c. After finished pairing with the second phone, turn off the headset, and then power on the first paired phone's Bluetooth function and then restart the headset. Then, the headset will connect to both the two paired phones automatically.

Recording operation

Button from left to right, followed by record, play, delete.

- Recording: Press "record button" and hear the "BI" sound, and the green light illuminate.

- Stop recording: Press "record button" when recording & you will hear a "BIBI" sound & the green LED light no longer illuminate.

(Note: In the recording process, when the memory is full, you will hear "BIBIBIBI" sound, and can not recording operation, and the LED light will not light up; headset can record up to 10 minutes of recording)

- Play: Press "play button," Play the latest recording; press "play button" again when recording is playing, it will play the last recording; the green LED lights will flash slowly.
- Stop: Press "the play button" two seconds; stop playing the recording; the green LED light goes out.
- Delete the latest recording: Press "delete button" two seconds, & will hear the "BI" sound; the green LED light turns off & flashes one time
- Delete all the recordings: Press "delete button" for 4-5 seconds, and will hear the "BIBIBI" sound; the green LED lights turns off after flashes one second

Troubleshooting:

If disconnection occurs, please check the following factors:

1. Ensure that the headset has enough power, is turned on and has been successfully paired to the mobile.
2. The Bluetooth® function of the mobile is enabled.
3. Ensure the distance between the headset and mobile is not over 30 feet, or there is wall or other disturbance or other electrical devices between headset and mobile.
4. Some mobile can support the switching between music and calling for Bluetooth® connection, while other phones will not support this function.

Important operation notice: Bluetooth® pairing

Bluetooth® pairing is the phrase used for Bluetooth® products use: it makes the Bluetooth® devices connect wirelessly to other devices via simple operation. For example, you must enable the Bluetooth® function on your mobile phone or device, if you want to use the mobile and Bluetooth® headset, then put the headset in pairing mode and search for the headset in your bluetooth function on your device, pair and connect by password.

Battery information:

Your device is powered by a rechargeable battery. The full performance of a new battery is achieved only after two or three completed charge and discharge cycles. The battery can be charged and discharged hundreds of times, but it will eventually wear out. Please disconnect the connection between charger and headset when not charging. Do not leave a fully charged battery connected to a charger for over 24 hours, since overcharging may shorten battery lifetime. If left unused, a fully charged battery will lose power over time. Leaving the device in extreme hot or cold temperatures, such as in closed car in summer or winter conditions, will reduce the capacity and lifetime of the battery. A device in extreme hot or cold environments may not work temporarily, even when the battery is fully charged. Battery performance is particularly limited in temperatures well below freezing. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire as they may explode. Battery may also explode if damaged.
