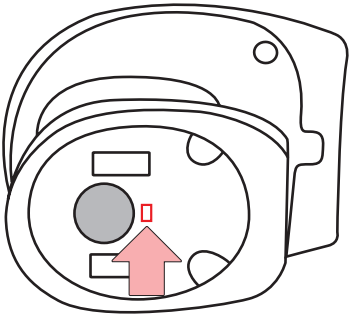

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

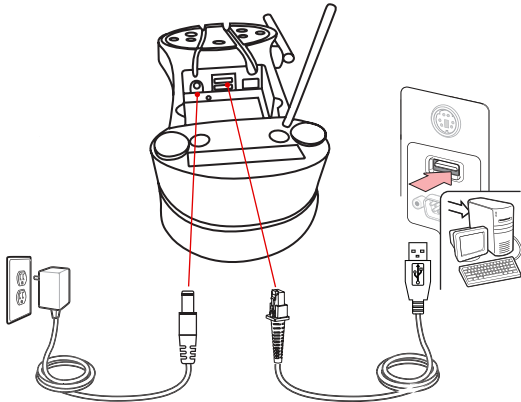
The following steps will walk you through the installation process.

STEP 1: POWER ON



Switch the power button to the on position.

STEP 2: CONNECT CABLES & CHARGE



Plug the power supply cable into the MS840B cradle and into an electrical outlet. Plug the interface cable into the MS840B cradle. Depending on which type you have chosen, you must also connect it to the USB, RS232, or PS/2 port on your computer. Charge for at least 5 hours.

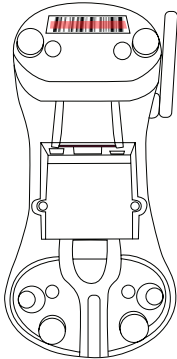
STEP 3: BEGIN PAIRING



Cradle Mode

Scan here to begin pairing the MS840B using the cradle.

STEP 4: SCAN CRADLE BARCODE



Scan the barcode label that appears under the cradle. The scanner will beep one time to indicate the pairing process has been successful. Your device is now ready to use.

TEST & FINISH

Open a word processing program such as Microsoft Word or Notepad on your host. Now scan the following barcode:



If the word “Unitech” appears on the screen you have successfully installed your scanner. Congratulations!

SETTINGS AND CONFIGURATION

The following section covers the most common configuration settings for your MS840B scanner.

FLASH MODE



Flash Mode

Scan here to switch to Flash Mode from the default Trigger Mode. In Flash mode, the MS840B will function automatically. It will scan at a set interval.

TRIGGER MODE



Trigger Mode

Scan here to switch back to Trigger Mode. In Trigger Mode, the MS840B will scan only when the scanner button is pressed.

TAB MODE



Tab Mode

You may wish to set your scanner to Tab Mode. In this mode, data will tab over to the next column as you scan instead of jumping to the next line. Scan the top barcode then the bottom barcode to switch to Tab Mode from the default Enter Mode.

ENTER MODE



Scan here to switch back to Enter Mode.

GOOD READ / BAD READ
