## Electronics retailer Newegg.com promotes its CEO to vice chairman

Newegg.com, an online retailer of computer components and consumer electronics, has promoted Ken Lam, formerly US CEO, to vice chairman, and named former strategic officer Simon Hsieh as CEO.

Sales at Newegg, founded in 2000, are approaching \$1 billion a year, the company says. Lam has been with the company from the start.
