

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
How do you qualify for your Windows® 7 upgrade from Toshiba?

Purchase a qualifying Windows® Vista-based Toshiba laptop and order your upgrade between June 26, 2009 and January 31, 2010. Qualifying Toshiba laptops and available upgrades are as follows:

Windows Vista Home Premium	Windows 7 Home Premium
Windows Vista Business	Windows 7 Professional
Windows Vista Ultimate	Windows 7 Ultimate

Windows XP, Windows Vista Starter, and Windows Vista Basic do NOT qualify for the upgrade.

What must you send to Toshiba to receive your Windows 7 upgrade?

In order to receive your upgrade, provide Toshiba with the Proof of Purchase (receipt or invoice), laptop part number, serial number, date and place of purchase, your name, ship to address, email address, and phone number. All Proof of Purchase must be received by the redemption center no later than February 28, 2010 (last postmark date). Some ID labels may have the part number labeled MODEL NO. Please note all part numbers begin with the letter 'P' and have 13 characters including the dash. Example: PSLD8U-0Q3033.

When will you receive your Windows® 7 Upgrade?



After the redemption center receives your Proof of Purchase and it is verified against the program requirements, your Windows® 7 Upgrade will be ready for processing. Orders will not be shipped until after the general availability of Windows 7.
