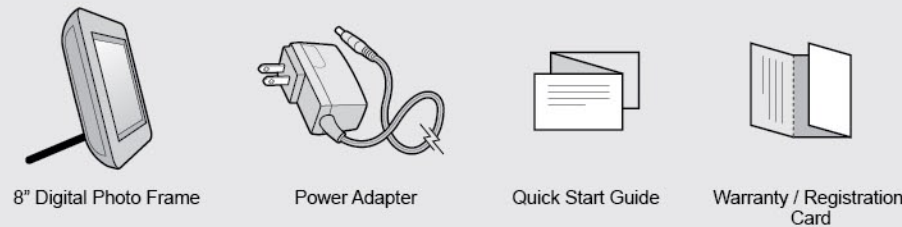

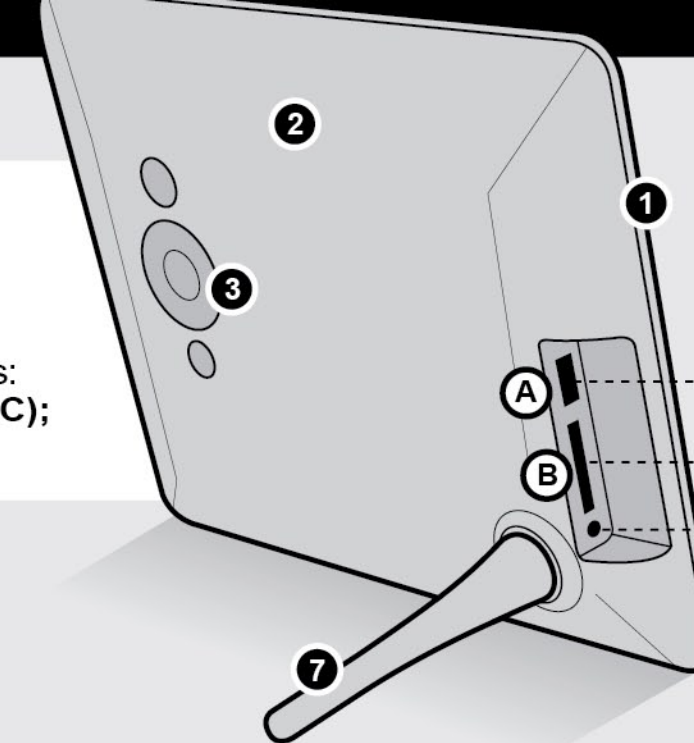

Highlights and Application

To easily view your favorite pictures:

- (A) Connect your USB hard drive / thumb drive through the unit's USB port
- OR**
- (B) Insert any of the following memory cards:
**Secure Digital High Capacity (SDHC);
Secure Digital (SD)**

Frame Control Close-Up

- 1 - Power On / Off (Hold until power turns on or off)
- 2 - Menu
 - (a) Press to return to previous screen
- 3 - Play / Pause
 - (a) Press to select option on Main Menu
 - (b) Press to pause slideshow
- 4 - Up Arrow
 - (a) Press to navigate UP when selecting options
 - (b) Press to select Previous file
- 5 - Down Arrow
 - (a) Press to navigate DOWN when selecting options
 - (b) Press to select Next file
- 6 - Left Arrow
 - (a) Press to navigate LEFT when selecting options
- 7 - Right Arrow
 - (a) Press to navigate RIGHT when selection options



Operating Instructions

Getting Started:

- Step 1: Remove the protective film covering the LCD.
- Step 2: Plug in the power adapter to power on the photo frame.

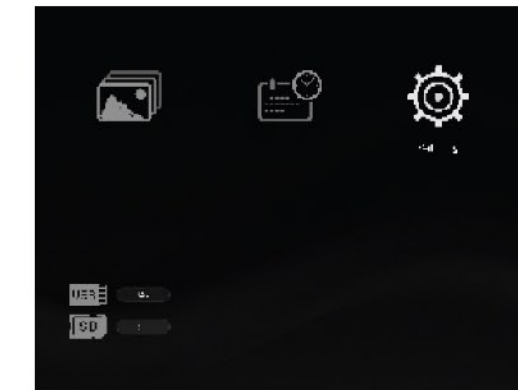
Turn ON / OFF the Digital Photo Frame:

- Power on**
Press the [Power] button on the device, the device will be turned on;
- Power off**
Press & hold the [Power] button on the device, the device will be turned off;
- Return to the Main Menu**
Press the [Home] button, the device will return to the Main Menu.

OSD and Memory Medium:

The Main Menu is shown below. Move the Left and Right buttons to select an icon, and press the [Enter] to enter.

Memory Menu
This device is equipped with external memory interfaces that is compatible with USB flash drive and SD/SDHC cards.



For refreshing the memory capacity, please press & hold the [Enter] button in the Memory Menu.

Slideshow:

Move [Left/Right] to select "Photo" in the Main Menu, and select a medium type in the drop-down menu, then enter slideshow by [Enter]. During the slideshow, move [Up/Down] for previous or next photo; press [Enter] for pause; Press [Home] to go back to the Photo Browser menu.

Calendar:

Move [Left/Right] to select "Calendar" in the Main menu, and press [Enter] to confirm. In the "Calendar" menu, press the [Up/Down] to browse thru the month.

Setup:

Move [Left/Right] to select "Setup" in the Main menu, and press [Enter] to confirm.

Photo Setup:

- Display Ratio:** move [Left/Right] to select from Crop to Fill, Full Screen and Fit to Screen.
- Slideshow Time:** move [Left/Right] to select from 5sec, 15sec, 30sec, 60sec, 5min and 15min.
- Transition Effect:** move [Left/Right] to select from 11 transition effects, such as Random, Snake and Partition, and etc.

Calendar Setup:

- Set Date:** move [Up/Down] to select, and [Left/Right] to change the value.
- Clock Mode:** move [Left/Right] to select between 12Hr and 24Hr.
- Set Time:** move [Up/Down] to select, and [Left/Right] to change the value.

System Setup:

- Language:** move [Left/Right] to select the on-screen language.
- Backlight:** move [Left/Right] to adjust the brightness level.
- Power On:** move [Left/Right] to set the Power On ON or OFF.
- Auto Boot Time:** set the timer for the device to turn on automatically. Move [Up/Down] to select option, and [Left/Right] to change the value.
- Power Off:** move [Left/Right] to set the Power Off ON or OFF.
- Auto Shut Time:** set the timer for the device to turn off automatically. Move [Up/Down] to select option, and [Left/Right] to change the value.
- Auto-Power Frequency:** move [Left/Right] to set the Auto-power frequency.
- USB Options:** It is for USB drive only for this model.
- Default:** reset to factory settings.
- Version:** display the version of the firmware.
- System Upgrade:** for software upgrade.
