
DO NOT insert the DGE-530T into the computer's PCI slot before installing the drivers.

Installing the DGE-530T Drivers

- Turn **ON** the computer.
- Insert the **driver CD**, which is included with the DGE-530T, into the CD-ROM drive.

The following window will appear.



Click on "Install Drivers".

For Windows 2000, Windows XP, XP 64bit, Windows 2003, Windows 2003 64bit and Vista x86/x64 users, the following screen will appear.



Click OK


For Windows 98SE and Windows ME users, this screen will be displayed.



Click Restart

Next, TURN OFF the computer and unplug the power cord.

2 Installing the DGE-530T into the computer's PCI slot




Caution: To avoid damage caused by static electricity, make sure to properly ground yourself by first touching a metal part of your computer to discharge any static electricity before working with the DGE-530T Ethernet Adapter.

- **Turn off** your computer and **unplug** the power cord.
- **Remove** the back cover of your computer. (Refer to your computer's manual if needed.)
- **Locate** an available PCI slot. PCI slots are usually white or cream colored.
- **Remove** the backplate (the small piece of metal that covers the opening for the PCI card on the back cover that you just removed.)
- **Insert** the DGE-530T carefully and firmly into the PCI slot.
- **Secure** the DGE-530T with the screw from the backplate.
- **Replace** your computer's cover.

3 Finishing the Installation

TURN ON the computer.


For **Windows 98SE** and **Windows ME** users, the following screen will appear.

Go to:

**START>SETTINGS>CONTROL
PANEL>SYSTEM>HARDWARE>DEVICE
MANAGER.**
