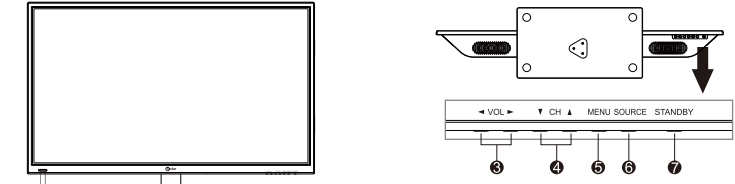


Wall Mounting Pattern

Mount this unit according to the instructions of the wall bracket(not supplied)

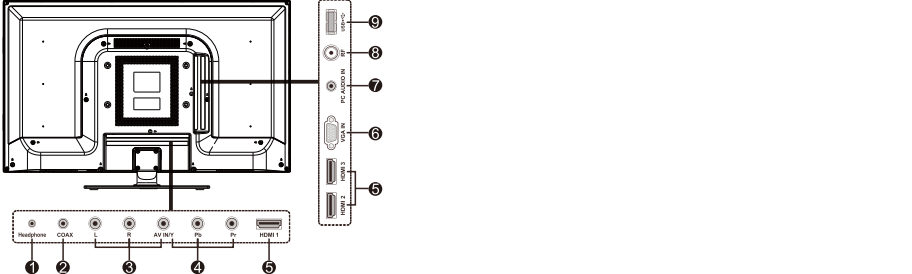


Front/Top View and Controls



Item	Description
1 POWER LED	Illuminates red when the TV is in standby mode.
2 IR(Infrared Receiver)	Receives IR signals from the remote control. Do not put anything near the sensor, as its function may be affected.
3 ◀VOL▶	These buttons increases/decreases the TV's volume. If a sub-menu is active, pressing these buttons will move the select right/left.
4 ◀CH▶	These buttons changes the TV channel up/down. If the OSD is active,these buttons functions as up/down for the menu.
5 MENU	This button activates the On Screen Display(OSD). If a sub-menu is active, pressing this button will exit the OSD.
6 SOURCE	This button switches between all the different sources of the TV. When the OSD is active, this button acts as the enter button and confirms the menu selection.
7 STANDBY	Turn on the TV by pressing the button once. Press the button again to turn off the TV.

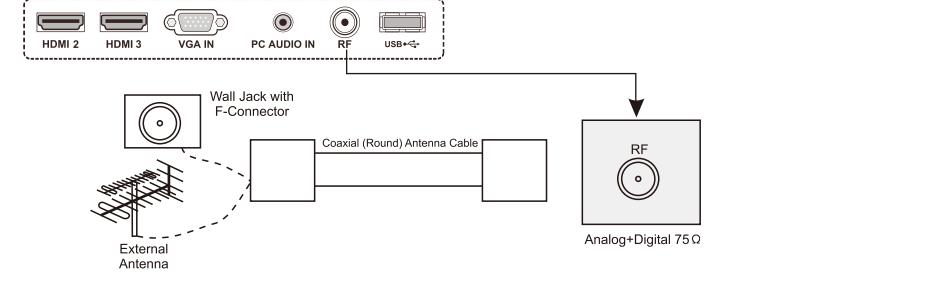
Rear View and Sockets



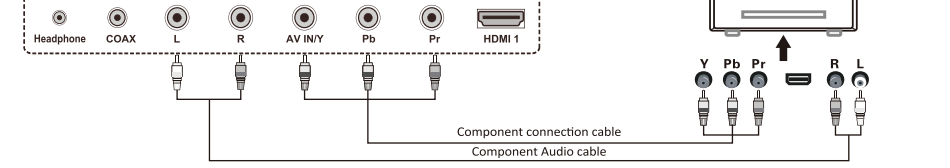
Socket	Description
1 HEADPHONE	This connection is for headphones to be attached to the TV.
2 COAX	This connection port is used for sending out digital audio signals to digital receivers. The orange (COAX SPDIF OUT) connector sends out either bit-stream or PCM digital sound signal to a home theater receiver with digital coax input.
3 AV IN/L/R	AV connects to devices that use composite video cables such as VCR or DVD player. This port shares the audio jacks with YPBPR.
4 YPBPR	This connection port is for DVD players or satellite / cable set-top boxes that use component cables. From left to right, connect green, blue, and red for video, and then connect white for left channel audio, and red for right channel audio. This port shares the audio jacks with AV.
5 HDMI 1/2/3	HDMI connects to devices that use HDMI cable,such as Blu-ray or HD DVD player, or HD cable / satellite set-top box. This connection port receives pure digital audio and high definition signal through one single cable. This port also can accept a HDCP video device for video.
6 VGA IN	This connection port connects to a PC for video using VGA cable. Be sure to connect your audio cable to the VGA Stereo input if you want sound out of VGA video source.
7 PC AUDIO IN	This connection port is for people who want to provide audio to the TV when using a PC or a DVI video device. The sources use 3.5mm mini-jack audio cable.
8 RF	This connection is for digital or analog cable without the cable box or over-the-airwave antennas.
9 USB	USB connects to USB flash drives for playing music and picture. The USB port is also used for updating the TV's firmware.

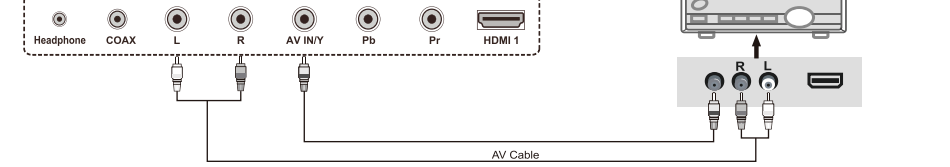

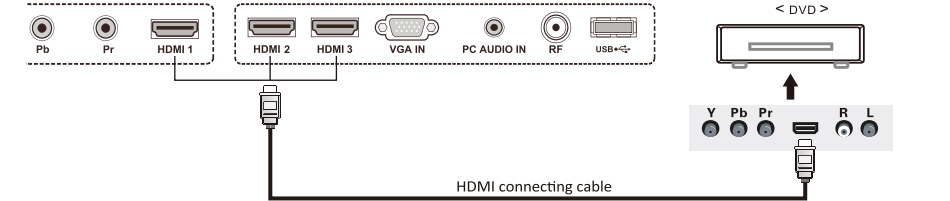
Connecting DVD Player with Component YpBPr...



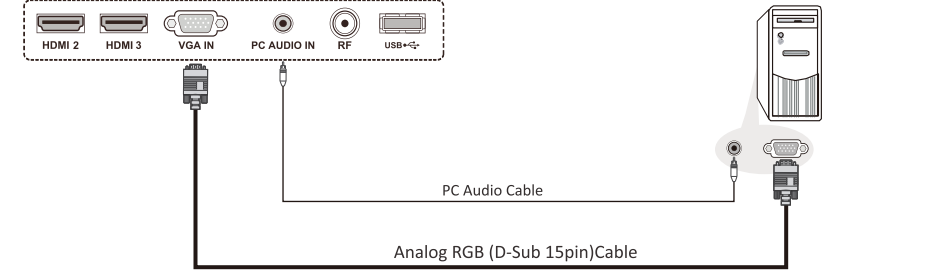
Connecting Wii™ with Composite...

Remote Control

POWER: This button turns the TV on or off.
SOURCE: Press to display and select the available video sources.
CC: This button turns on the closed captioning system of the television. Please Note : CC only works under the sources TV, AV.

MTS: In TV mode, under ATV channel switches the Stereo, Mono and SAP. Under DTV channel switches the Audio Language.

MUTE: This button stops the TV from producing any sound.

0-9 : These buttons allow you to access the channels directly. When accessing a digital channel you would use these buttons in junction with the (-) button to switch channels.

(-) : This button allows you to access digital channels directly when used in junction with the number buttons 0-9.

R : This button allows you to swift between the current channel and the last channel you watched.

GUIDE: This button turns on the electronic program guide that is received from antenna.

INFO: This function tells you the LCD's current display information.

▲▼◀▶ENTER: These buttons allow you to navigate inside the OSD menu. They also function as CH+/- for digital channels in the tuner.

MENU: This button turns on the on screen display menu (OSD).

EXIT: This button allows you to quit from the OSD menu

VOL(+/-): These two buttons increase or decrease the volume of the TV.

CH(+/-): These two buttons change the TV channel back and forth.

ASPECT : This button changes the TV between different display modes.

FREEZE : This button freezes the video. Press the button again to unfreeze.

SLEEP : This button enables the sleep function so the TV turns itself off after the designated time.

FAV : This button opens the favorite channel list.

FAV (+/-) : Press FAV +/- to change forward/ backward Fav channel for TV.

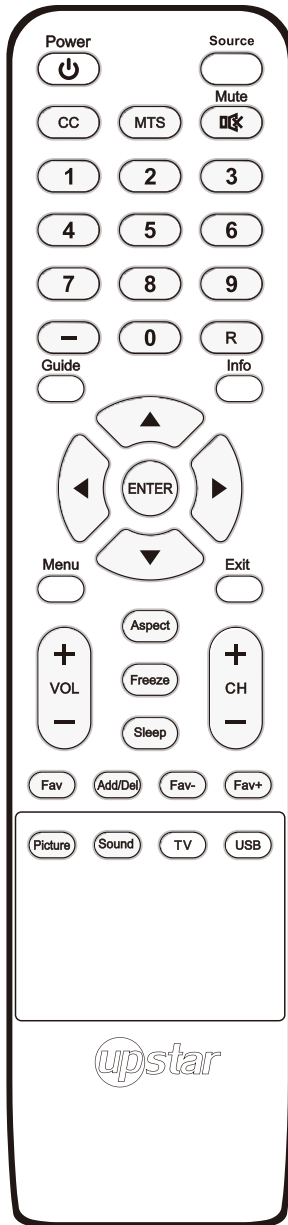
ADD/DEL: This button adds/deletes a channel to the favorites list while you are using the TV tuner.

PICTURE : This button selects different optimized picture settings for the TV.

SOUND : This button selects different optimized sound settings for the TV.

TV: Press to select the TV mode directly

USB: This button enables the USB picture and MP3 playing function in the TV.



Basic Use

Starting up the HDTV

1. Make sure your power cable is connected and the standby red light in the front of the TV is lit up.
2. Check all your connection cables off the side or the back of your TV and also your AV devices. Make sure they are all connected securely.
3. Turn on your TV and other AV devices if necessary. Powering the LED TV

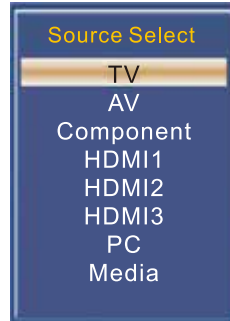
Power on /off

Press the POWER button on the TV /remote control to turn the LED TV on .
press the POWER button on the TV / remote control again to turn the LED TV off.

Selecting Input Source

- 1.Press the SOURCE button on the bottom of the TV or the SOURCE button on the remote control and you will see the picture left.

- 2.Use ▲/▼ buttons to select the source what you want to switch to . Press ENTER button to confirm .



OSD (On Screen Display) Options

1. Press MENU button to open the menu,the On Screen Display(OSD) will appear on the screen



2. Use the ◀/▶ buttons to select you're your main menu option and press ENTER.

PICTURE This main option has functions for changing the picture settings for all ports, such as tint, contrast, sharpness.

SOUND This main option has functions for changing sound settings for all ports, such as Type, treble, bass, and acoustic cinema enhancement....etc.

TIME This main option has functions for changing the TV's time display, time format, and sleep timer.

SETUP This main option has functions for all ports, OSD language, caption styles, time setup, automatic synchronization, sleep timer and power on timer, power off timer.

LOCK This main options has functions for parental filter / blocking.

CHANNEL This main option has functions for the tuner port, such as scanning channels, editing channels, specific range scans, audio language, tuner mode....etc.

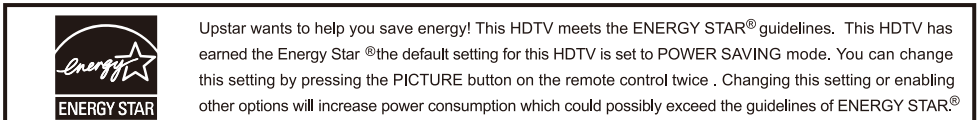
